Experiments on Nonhuman Animals: “Experiments on Nonhuman Animals” means any research of any sort using, in whole or in part, living or dead animals, including, without limitation, fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds, insects, nonhuman mammals, or other species, except for the following, which are considered humane and acceptable;

(1) naturalistic studies, in which animals are observed, without interference, in their natural setting, or

(2) experimental treatments in animals who need them due to clinical illness, without the specific expectation or intention of application to related human diseases, and who are not bred for research purposes.

The Health Charity shall submit the original of this executed Statement of Assurance to the Australian Association for Humane Research Inc. and retain a copy of this document at the Charity’s principle place of business.
